Tailings Dams and the Coal Industry:  
Where to from here?**

Recent events in western Canada have focussed attention on tailings dams and the risks associated with them. The coal industry has historically, and continues, to use “conventional” tailings dams for the impoundment of coal process and combustion wastes. However, the industry has recognized the need to evaluate alternatives in the face of greater scrutiny and lower risk tolerance from both internal and external stakeholders. This talk will review the current state of practice for conventional dams as well as discuss alternatives and their implications for coal operations and projects going forward.

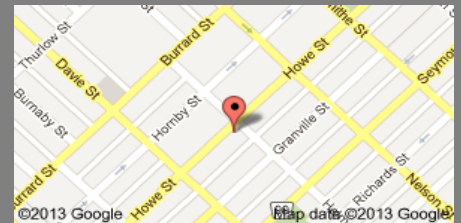
